The estimated project total installation costs (TIC)/ construction costs (CN) by scenario for central waterfront are as follows:

1. Scenario A \$840 million
2. Scenario B \$840 million
3. Scenario C \$890 million
4. Scenario D \$1,340 million
5. Scenario E \$1,810 million
6. Scenario F \$2,500 million
7. Scenario G \$1,850 million
8. Scenario H \$1,390 million

Please note that the above costs are at planning level or rough order of magnitude (ROM) type with **no** escalation, contingency/ risk and are subject to further review.
