Hi Emily-

A few comments for consideration:

Slide 3: I would say that "transition to existing viaduct" would not be a relevant design consideration for the bored tunnel south portal. Replace that one with something like "Support goal of tunnel open to traffic by 2015"

Slide 4: Switch bullets 3 and 4, so that it matches with the order of the work. State approximate dates: "Keeps traffic moving on existing viaduct during tunnel construction." "Connects to bored tunnel and city street grid when tunnel is complete in 2015."

Slide 5: last bullet, state construction as "early 2010 to late 2012"

Slide 7: Please add a small note to each drawing on the right side with an arrow To I-5 <arrow right>
