The answer to question 1 is

- Parametrix provided minimal support to the IPMT in the first half of January '09 and it is possible that additional budget for an update to AAA.02.RFS.03 will not be needed for Parametrix.
- PB continues with Air Quality/Noise Assessment comment responses through 01/31/09, and will wrap up technical issues on Air&Noise by 1/31 as well. No additional monies will be needed for PB.

Be advised that given the Governor's decision to move forward with a Bored Tunnel, the STATE is requesting the IMP team complete all its work by January 2009; thereafter, the STATE's expectation is that the IMP team will support it in limited, on call role through the upcoming legislative session.

Given this, the STATE has the following questions on AAA.02.RFS.03.Update 1 - Environmental Support on an Add-needed Basis:

Regarding Scope Part 1 – IMP support. Given the reduced role of the IMP going forward, what support would the CONSULTANT provide, who would provide it, and to what extent would this support come out of the proposed 250 hours?

Regarding Scope Part 2 – NEPA- related activities. Given the several "B" series environmental task order already "on the books" coupled with the fact we are processing Task Order Y-9715 CC today for CONSULTANT signature, the STATE is wondering whether the tasks outlined in Scope Part 2 are already covered in the "B" series of TOs and in CC. If not, who would provide this support and to what extent?
