I saw Rob Johnson today and asked him about the topics the environmental groups were most interested in covering on Friday. You may already know this, but just in case not...

- 1. Environmental process -- what is it, what is the scoping process that we're in today, what's going to be included in the EIS? Sounds like there is some interest in including I-5 as part of the "systems solution."
- 2. Timing and funding -- what is the commitment to fully fund all parts of the hybrid alternative; right now it appears the only thing with committed funding is the bored tunnel. The multi-modal aspects of the alternative (including the central waterfront) appears to be the last thing to happen.
- 3. Safety -- how is the commitment to take down the viaduct in 2012 being addressed? This also relates to the timing issue -- with a potential delay in taking down the viaduct, they also see a delay in improving the waterfront for pedestrians and bicyclists.

Rob won't be there (attending the U-Link groundbreaking). Hope this is helpful -- let me know if you need any help getting ready for it.
