

Overall:

- Representatives of the AWW Program have presented to Pioneer Square residents, businesses and affiliated organizations at least 30 times since 2001, talking with more than 600 individuals
- The program has mailed or e-mailed at least 25 project-related notices over the past three years to residents and businesses in Pioneer Square
- The program has held public open houses, visited neighborhood businesses and events and maintained steady contact with stakeholders in Pioneer Square

2008 activities:

- Presented detailed information to the Pioneer Square Community Association three times (Dec. 17, Nov. 24, Oct. 23)
- Presented to the city's Parking and Access Review Committee, which has Pioneer Square representation, twice (Dec. 18, Aug. 21)
- Spoke individually with approximately 100 Pioneer Square businesses regarding the Dec. 15 central waterfront open house
- Hung posters at 16 different Pioneer Square locations to inform the neighborhood of the Dec. 15 Central Waterfront open house.
- Pioneer Square was represented by Craig Montgomery during the early part of the Stakeholder Advisory Committee effort; staff changes at the community association did not become permanent until late summer 2008, three months prior to completion of stakeholder process.
- Sent at least eight written notices regarding the project to the surrounding neighborhood
- Held a South Downtown Projects Preview in April, to answer questions and educate people in Pioneer Square and other south end neighborhoods about coming construction in the area

2007 activities:

- Presented to the Pioneer Square Community Association twice (Oct. 9 and Oct. 18)
- Presented to the city's Parking and Access Review Committee (Sept. 20)
- Held two public open houses in August, specifically for businesses and residents of Pioneer Square
- Staffed a booth at the Pioneer Square Fire Festival
