**Dear Bored Tunnel Hybrid supporter,**

**Last night you made history! Thanks to your extraordinary efforts, the House of Representatives passed the Bored Tunnel bill (SB 5768) by a vote of 53 to 43. It is now expected to pass in the Senate (which approved an earlier version) and move to the Governor's desk where it will be signed into law.**

**Your emails and phone calls over the past several months truly made a difference! When Rep. Dean Takko rose to speak in support of the bill last night, he said "I wish I had a dollar for every email I got saying 'I support the Bored Tunnel'. I would be a wealthy man now."**
