- RapidRide one word- both R's capitalized.
- West Seattle map- bottom right- Light Rail Light is spelled wrong, we should also be consistent and say Link Light Rail.
- West Seattle map- should be centered further south. It focuses on the north end too much- with the Street
  Car and Link Light Rail. The focus for the West Seattle map should be RapidRide and the new Water Taxi
  service.
