Near the end the draft says one million hours of transit service will carry 17,000 riders. The million hours are annual and the 17,000 is daily. I think the million annual hours is also the total incremental hours to a future year, 2015?, including service increases from Transit Now, etc, not just the new services financed in the Tri-Agency hybrid proposal. The total number of new daily riders in 2015 from all sources is estimated to be 70,000.

So at a minimum I'd recommend you change the answer to say one million annual hours financed from a combination of sources to carry 70,000 additional riders each weekday.
