Hi,

Today I met with Joshua Johnston, who is an aide to King County Councilmember Julia Patterson. In addition to giving him a general overview briefing on the SR 520 program, I gave him the packet that you passed out today at the AWV event.

He has some questions that I could not answer:

- When does the existing viaduct come down -- 2012 or later?
- When will the new surface street on Alaskan Way be complete?
- He would like a more detailed breakdown of the costs & responsibilities than what is shown in the folio. For example, he noticed that the City of Seattle is pledging to spend more (\$135 M) on "transit infrastructure and services" than King County (\$115 M). What are the infrastructure (improved E/W Mercer and Spokane Streets?) and service (new bus service?) improvements?

Julia's office is generally more concerned with the viaduct than SR 520, so he is going to check with Julia to see if she would like a personal AWV briefing with project staff. I will keep you posted.
