Allen Schaufler from KING 5 TV interviewed Dave Dye today about the next steps on the plan to replace the Alaskan Way Viaduct with a deep bored tunnel. Dave was interviewed at the construction site for the early electrical work and future site of the bored tunnel south portal. He talked about the bored tunnel configuration; how it will be constructed; and the major construction work that will start next year on removing the south mile of the viaduct. A short segment will air on KING 5 tonight and a longer segment on Up Front on Sunday. Allen is also talking to Elizabeth Campbell who is sponsoring a Seattle referendum to stop the bored tunnel plan. Allen was provided with contact information for other interest groups to interview.
