Probably a good idea for me to provide a summary my discussion with Mike so far. We had asked whether or not they had any thoughts of pursuing the D-B work, he indicated that they were with us all the way in terms of environmental support and the preliminary engineering to support a D-B. Mike asked about the RFP, I told him that I saw it as a cooperative effort, with PB providing the preliminary engineering content and other input, but it would be lead by WSDOT working with HMM. I have assumed that we continue to retain HMM in their current role complementing us in terms of program management and design oversight and QA/QC support. In light of the bored tunnel decision, between HMM and Reilly/Parker, we are well stocked in terms of owner's rep support.

Today Gordon came in today trying to make a case that we should consider D-B-B, thinking the final design could be completed before Dec. 2010. Other than the fact we would have to go open competitive on the design beyond that required for the EIS, I gave him some other compelling reasons why it seems unlikely we are going in that direction. I guess the bottom line is - and this is at the heart of a number of John Reilly discussions - we need to lead this decisively, utilizing the range of resources available to us. Since I am not going to be there for the meeting you have with Jared next week, I just want to make sure we are all on the same page.

Maybe we can chat tomorrow?
